

An Introduction to knitr

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The **knitr** package (Xie, 2012) is an alternative tool to Sweave based on a different design with more features. This document is not the real vignette, but only serves as a placeholder to guide you to the real manuals of this package. You can find them in the package website: <http://yihui.name/knitr>¹, and remember to read the help pages of functions in this package.

Anyway, here is a code chunk that shows you can compile vignettes with **knitr** as well by using a proper Makefile (see <http://yihui.name/knitr/demo/vignette/>):
